Subject : Proposed Requirements for Flight Deck Security

Enclosed herewith you will find an FAA Notice dated 17th June 2002 in which that administration specifies an amendment to 14 CFR Part 129 requiring Phase I and Phase II flight deck doors.

The FAA rule does not apply to UAE Civil Aviation operations at this time rpt at this time. However operators of passenger carrying transport aircraft and transport category all cargo aircraft (having doors between the cockpit and an occupied compartment) operating to the USA under 14 CFR Part 129 or intending to do so shall adhere to the enclosed FAA Rule.

Finally, you are hereby advised that the GCAA intends to introduce Flight Deck Door Security Enhancement Requirements on all rpt all UAE registered aircraft (having doors between the cockpit and an occupied compartment) operating internationally in the air carrier and air transport categories.
