Subject : Aeronautical Parts Supplier Requirements

All UAE GCAA approved aeronautical parts suppliers are reminded to comply with the following GCAA policies, which are considered mandatory for the persistence of their existing GCAA Aeronautical Parts Supplier Approval:

- 1- All aeronautical parts are to be brought directly from the manufacturer rather than third party and the supplier shall provide evidence on demand, if so warranted.
- 2- In case otherwise procured, the supplier must be able to satisfy the GCAA with an alternative means of compliance with the requirements.
- 3- The supplier must have a qualified Quality Inspector or equivalent to ensure that the quality systems as per the approved Company Exposition are strictly followed within the organisation.
- 4- Quality Inspector must receive continuation training within two years period.
- 5- The supplier must have appropriate facility to inspect and store the aeronautical parts.

Failure to comply with the above requirements within six months period from the date of this letter may result in GCAA taking appropriate enforcement action.
