### 2. AMENDMENTS

#### 2.1 CARs Part VII Chapter 1 Page 1-1 Paragraph 1.4.5

The Authority shall provide suitable protection and handling procedures for sensitive security information, shared by other Contracting States, or sensitive security information that affects the security interests of other Contracting States, in order to ensure that inappropriate use or disclosure of such information is avoided.

#### **Amendment**

The Authority shall provide suitable protection and handling procedures for security information, ***including sensitive security information***, shared by other Contracting States, or sensitive security information that affects the security interests of other Contracting States, in order to ensure that inappropriate use or disclosure of such information is avoided.

## 2.2 CARs Part VII Chapter 1 Page 1-2 Paragraph 2.2.2

The Authority has designated to ICAO the Department of Aviation Safety and Security to be responsible for the development, implementation and maintenance of the national civil aviation security programme.

### Amendment

The Authority has designated the Department of Aviation Safety and Security to be responsible for the development, implementation and maintenance of the national civil aviation security programme.

## 2.4 CARs Part VII Chapter 2 Page 2-3 Paragraph 4.3.1

The Airport Authority shall establish measures to ensure that originating passengers and their cabin baggage are screened prior to boarding an aircraft engaged in international civil aviation operations.

### Amendment

The Airport Authority, *in concert with the Police*, shall establish measures to ensure that originating passengers and their cabin baggage are screened prior to boarding an aircraft engaged in international civil aviation operations.

The said amendments will be introduced in the next revision of the NCASP in January 2006 until such time the amendments reflected below shall supersede the current NCASP.
